PRIVACY NOTICE FOR CUSTOMERS AND SUPPLIERS

1. INTRODUCTION

By means of this notice, Fast Milano S.p.A., with registered office in Cernusco sul Naviglio (MI), Via Brescia 58, Italy, hereinafter referred to as the “Company” or the “Controller”, in its capacity as data controller, informs you that your personal data hereinafter referred to as the “Personal Data” shall be processed in accordance with this privacy notice.

2. WHO IS THE DATA CONTROLLER?

The Company is the data controller in respect of the processing of the Personal Data.

3. WHAT CATEGORIES OF PERSONAL DATA ARE PROCESSED BY THE COMPANY?

The Controller shall process the following categories of Personal Data:

- identification data, such as, by way of example, name, surname, tax code, address, telephone number, email address, etc.;
- bank details necessary for the performance of the contractual services.

4. FOR WHAT PURPOSES ARE THE PERSONAL DATA PROCESSED?

The Company processes the Personal Data of data subjects by manual, automated and/or electronic means for the following purposes:

4.1 to carry out the activities necessary and preparatory to the conclusion and management of the contract, hereinafter also referred to as the “Contract”, as well as to fulfil the obligations arising from the performance of the Contract, hereinafter the “Contractual Purposes”;

4.2 to comply with obligations laid down by applicable laws or regulations, for example in relation to anti-mafia and/or anti-money laundering legislation, as well as with provisions issued by the competent tax authorities, hereinafter the “Legal Purposes”.

5. WHAT IS THE LEGAL BASIS FOR THE PROCESSING?

The processing of Personal Data is mandatory:

- for the performance of the Contract, in relation to the purposes referred to in paragraph 4.1;
- for compliance with legal obligations, in relation to the purposes referred to in paragraph 4.2.

Refusal to provide the Personal Data for the purposes referred to in paragraphs 4.1 and 4.2 shall prevent the Company from entering into the Contract and, where the Contract has already been entered into, from continuing its performance.

6. HOW LONG ARE THE PERSONAL DATA RETAINED?

The Personal Data shall be retained for the period necessary to carry out the administrative and contractual activities relating to the purposes referred to in paragraph 4 and for as long as there remains any uncertainty as to the need to use them in order to properly comply with legal obligations and/or respond to requests from Public Authorities.

Once the maximum retention period has expired, the Personal Data shall be destroyed.

For the purposes referred to in paragraph 4.2, the maximum retention period shall be 6 six years from the date of collection.

7. WHO HAS ACCESS TO THE PERSONAL DATA?

The Company may disclose the Personal Data of data subjects to:

- collaborators, employees and suppliers of the Company, within the scope of their duties and/or any contractual obligations with them, in connection with commercial relationships with customers or suppliers;
- legal, administrative and tax advisers who assist the Company in carrying out its activities;
- banking institutions for the management of receipts and payments arising from the performance of the Contract with customers or suppliers;

- sub-suppliers and/or subcontractors engaged in activities connected with the performance of the Contract with the Company, acting as external data processors;
- public bodies and/or judicial and/or supervisory authorities, where so requested by them, acting as independent data controllers; and
- cloud or IT service providers.

8. ARE THE PERSONAL DATA TRANSFERRED ABROAD?

The Personal Data of data subjects shall not be transferred to countries outside the European Economic Area.

9. WHAT RIGHTS DOES THE DATA SUBJECT HAVE IN RELATION TO THEIR PERSONAL DATA?

Each data subject may exercise a number of important rights, which are provided for and governed by the applicable legislation, in order to obtain information on:

- the purposes and methods of the processing, i.e. the purpose indicated in paragraph 4;
- the categories of Personal Data, i.e. what types of data are processed;
- the recipients or categories of recipients to whom the Personal Data have been or will be disclosed, in particular where such recipients are located in third countries or are international organisations, i.e. who will process the data and whether they will be disclosed to third parties and whether such disclosure will involve non-EU countries;
- the envisaged retention period for the Personal Data or, where this is not possible, the criteria used to determine that period, i.e. how long the data will be processed;
- where the Personal Data are not collected from the data subject, any available information as to their source;
- the existence of automated decision-making, including profiling, and, at least in such cases, meaningful information about the logic involved, as well as the significance and envisaged consequences of such processing for the data subject.

The data subject also has the right to request from the Controller the rectification or erasure of the Personal Data, or the restriction of processing of the Personal Data concerning them, or to object to their processing.

If the data subject is not satisfied with the responses received, they may lodge a complaint, where the relevant conditions are met, with the Supervisory Authority.
